The Stars Rallye Télévie will be off to a lively start from the Autoworld Museum at the Esplanade du Cinquantenaire on 20 October, leaving at 9:30 a.m. and at noon at the Namur Airport, Temploux around 11:30 a.m. The arrival will take place around 4.30pm at Autoworld in Brussels.

All the money raised in this 12th edition – which features for the very first time two Children's Rallies – will be transferred directly to the FRNS/FWO (the Belgian Foundation for Scientific Research). The goal for 2019 is €120 000.

The event launch press conference take place on Tuesday, 24 September, with event partners and participants in attendance, at Club des V, 280 Avenue Kersbeek, 1190 Brussels (bordering 1180).

This will also mark the start of the online Grand Auction to purchase a seat in the car of your dreams with a star or celebrity next to you. The auction ends one week before the rally takes place.

The event is an excellent mix of ingredients and combines everything necessary to guarantee participation: energy and talent. Taking an active part are leading members of the science community, icons from the worlds of sport and culture, and stars of the small screen. Their participation has ensured the ongoing success of the Télévie and its Rallye over the years. A veritable institution.

The honorary chairman of the Rallye Télévie is Pierre Sonveaux, Research Chair with the FRS-FNRS, specialising in cancer research. As with every year's edition, all money raised in the event is transferred directly to the FNRS/FWO (the Belgian Foundation for Scientific Research) to fund cancer and leukaemia research.

Over its 11 years, the Rallye Télévie has raised more than €1 000 000 for cancer research, reaching €118 000. The target amount for this year's edition is set at €120 000.
